ADMINISTRATION REPORT OF THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT FOR THE YEAR 2018-2019

1. INTRODUCTION

r d r r:- This report projects a survey of the Administrative and constructive performance of the Department during the year 2018-19. The report briefly gives an assessment of functioning of the Department, financial and physical targets achieved under various schemes, Department Publications, implementation of Right to Information Act, Events, Miscellaneous matters etc

☐ *r r d r* :- The performance of the department narrated in the report is mainly about the execution of works included in the budget estimate for 2018-2019 and those sanctioned under Central Government Schemes. The objectives and performances are narrated in Section III of the report.

:- The quantum of financial operation of this Department under various heads of accounts is shown in Section IV. The tables appended to this report reveal a picture of financial achievements during the year 2018-2019. The department had allocation under Plan and non plan schemes for various wings and expenditure is also shown in the table.

2. ORGANISATION STRUCTURE

r d
Public Works Department is a department under the Government of state of Kerala, India. It manages the construction and maintenance of civil structures owned by the government viz, government buildings, government owned hospitals, schools, roads, bridges etc. The KPWD was formed in 1956 following reorganisation of states and Buildings wing was formed in 1986. The PWD Code was introduced in 1901. In 1949 when United state of Travancore –Cochin was formed both the Maramath Departments under Kingdom of Travancore and Cochin were merged and renamed as Kerala PWD.

The PWD Manual is the basic document which outlines the functioning of Public Works Department. The PWD manual was originally prepared in the year 1972 and since then the structure and functioning methodology of the department have undergone major changes. In the last so many years drastic changes have been occurred in the field of execution/implementation of Public Works. Moreover, standards and specification have developed and published by Government various authorised agencies on the construction and maintenance of Roads, Bridges, and Buildings etc. Therefore, considering all these aspects in accordance with the existing practices and procedures Government have suitably revised PWD manual as Kerala Public Works Department Manual Revised Edition 2012 incorporating all Government Orders upto 31/10/2018.

The revised Manual should be followed by the entire officers of the Department and pertains to Investigation, Design, Planning, Estimating, Bidding (Tendering), Execution and Maintenance of all types of works generally carried out by the various wings of PWD.

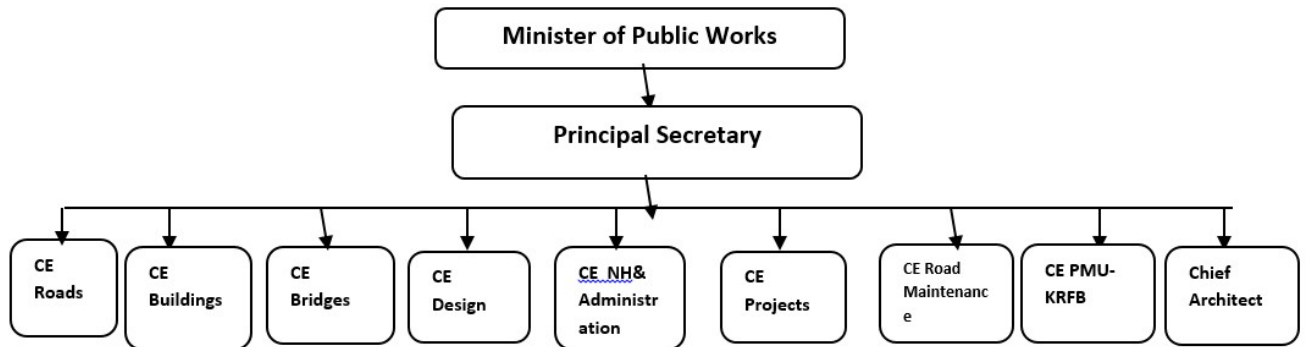
Realizing that brief description on Quality Control in the PWD Manual is not sufficient to bring out required quality in projects, PWD has released a Quality Control Manual to ensure quality of works.

The Minister (Works) is in charge of the Kerala Public Works Department. The Minister is assisted by the Secretary for public works who heads the secretariat functions. A major concept in PWD's organisational framework is based upon managing the programme delivery by separate wings, headed by the Chief Engineers.

The operational units of each wing are geographically distributed and tiered by circles under which are the divisions that generally correspond to the districts of Kerala. The execution of works is supervised and completed through the Executive Engineer. The construction works of roads, bridges, buildings, repairs, renovation and maintenance work thereof is looked after by each division under its

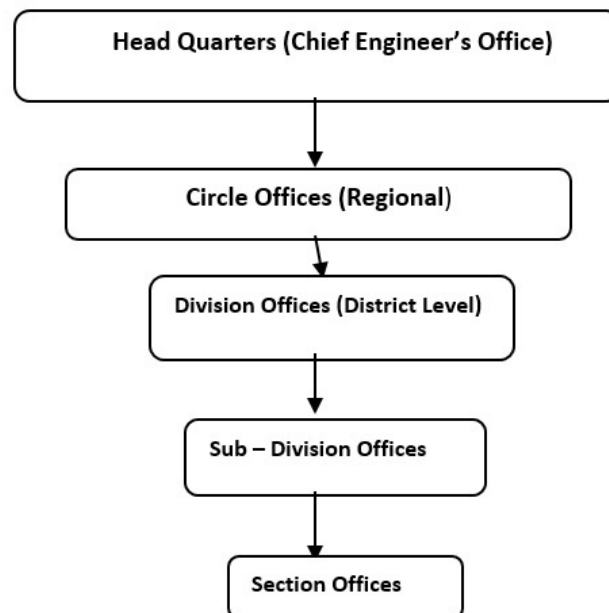
territorial jurisdiction. The Divisions are divided into a number of subdivisions in charge of Assistant Executive Engineers and the Subdivisions in turn are divided into a number of Sections under charge of Assistant Engineers.

2.1.1 Organisational Chart



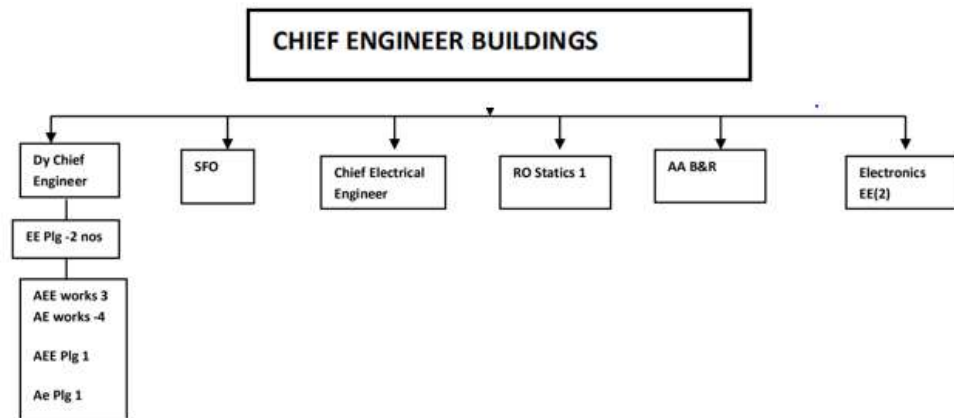
2.1.2 Organisational set up

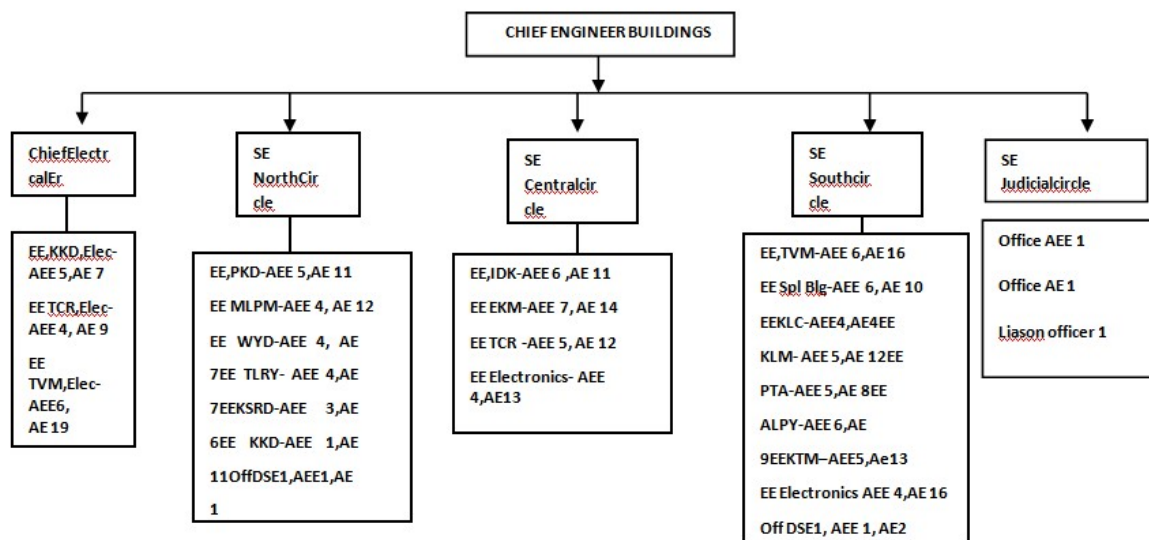

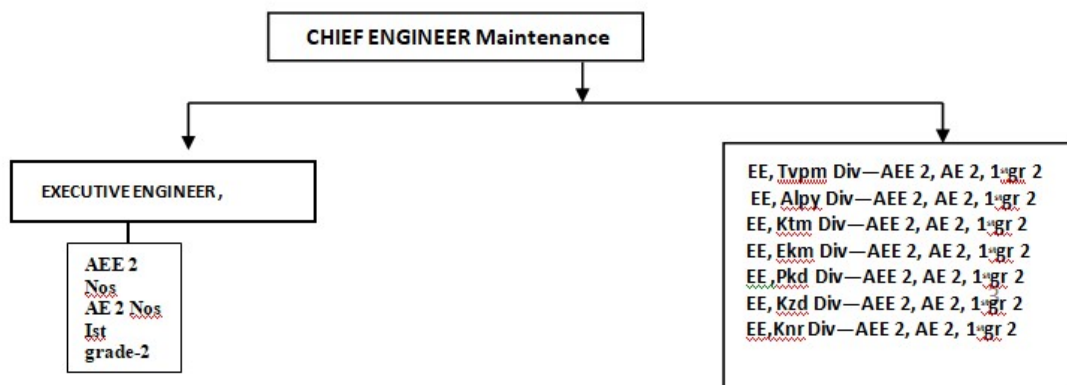

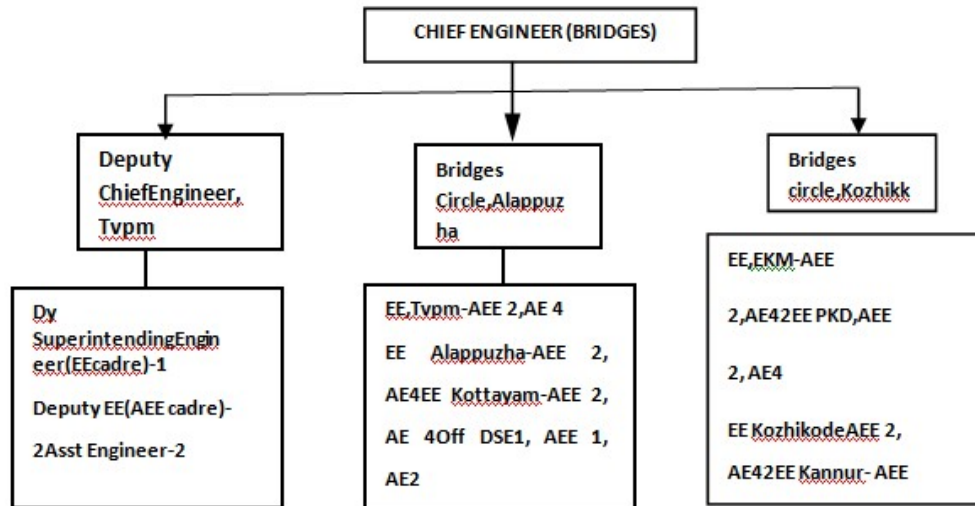

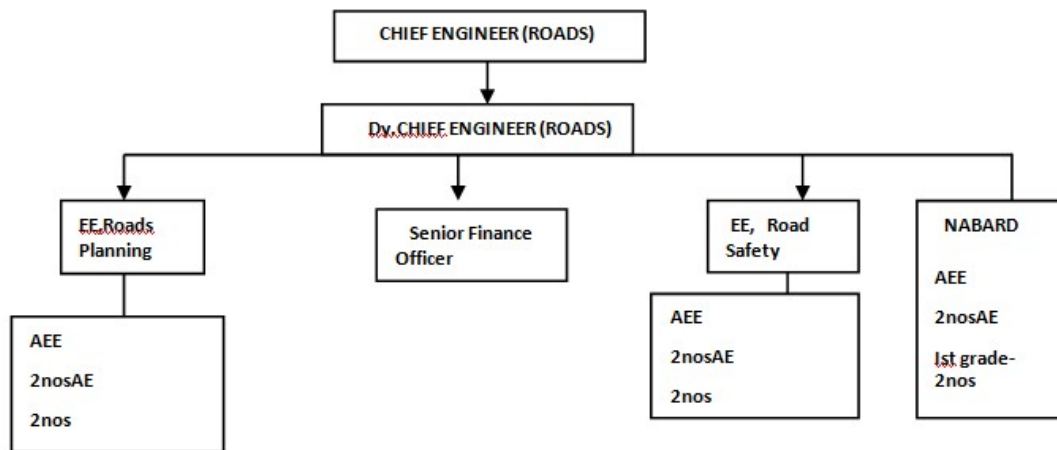

3. OBJECTIVES AND PERFORMANCE OF THE BUILDINGS WING

The Building wing deal with planning, project preparation, construction and maintenance of Government Buildings, arrangements of works of public building including water supply, electrification and electronics works. Buildings maintained by PWD also include many heritage structures of prestigious nature. While attending to repairs of such buildings it is ensured that the original characteristics and aesthetics of these structures are preserved.

PWD Buildings is also responsible for issuance of rent certificate in respect of private buildings taken on rent for functioning of Government offices and also issue Valuation certificate. Energy saving and conservation measures are being ensured by incorporating them in building plan. Rain water harvesting and waste disposal system are being made mandatory. Necessary measures are being taken to implement the Government's Green Building Policy as per GRIHA in all the building constructions by PWD.

The Architectural wing is headed by the Chief Architect, in the grade and rank of the The Architectural wing of Public Works Department deals with the complete Architectural design process of all Government buildings, throughout the entire State of Kerala.

- The Architectural wing has 4 Senior Architects and 13 Deputy Architects
- Each Deputy Architect has been given the charge of one District exclusively
- Each Senior Architect deals with the works of 3 districts, .
- To improve the functionality and aesthetics of buildings under PWD, all the designs forwarded from this wing is' being scrutinized by an in-house Design Review Committee comprising the Chief Architect, Deputy Chief Architect and four Senior Architects.
- The development of architectural designs. from the conceptual stage to the final design shall be in the purview of the Design Review Committee.
- One team under Technical Assistant in Architectural wing shall be deputed to. inspect, the site after completion of the project to check whether the work is done according to the approved architectural design and drawing and to prepare the Completion Plan for getting the Occupation Certificate.

The design procedure includes various stages, which are mentioned in detail below:

➤ Site Inspection

Once the detailed requirement list and total station Survey report of the site is received in this office from the Client Department (through the concerned Divisional Offices), an officer in the cadre of Deputy Architect will inspect the site to check the feasibility of the Project and have discussions with the concerned officials.

➤ Preparation Of Preliminary Sketch Design

The next stage involved is the preparation of preliminary sketch: design taking into consideration: of various factors such as the topography of site, the character of neighbouring buildings, the soil conditions, the building byelaws, orientation of the site, the access towards the site, and as per the given requirements. The preliminary Sketch design thus prepared is sent to the concerned Divisional office for getting approval from the concerned authorities (Client Department).

➤ Preparation Of Detailed Working Drawings

When the approved copy of preliminary sketch design is received in this office, a detailed working drawing, showing all probable details such as detailed plans with various levels and dimensions, material specifications, joinery and opening sizes, detailed sections, showing the height and levels of all floors, surface slabs, sections through staircases, front and side elevations etc is prepared in this office. The prepared drawing is checked, verified and sent to Chief Engineer, Buildings, Public Works Department, (with a set of drawing), The Chief Engineer, Design

Administration, Public Works Department (with a set of drawing and soft copy) The concerned Division Office. of Public Works Department (with three sets of drawing and a soft copy in PDF format) and to the Superintending Engineer (Electrical) (with one set of drawing and a soft copy.)

8. OBJECTIVES AND PERFORMANCE OF THE NATIONAL HIGHWAYS WING

r

8.1.1 Statutory and non-statutory functions

The report is mainly about the execution of works included in the budget estimate for 2018 – 19 and those sanctioned under various schemes of various Central Government Schemes.

The Chief Engineer is the administrative and professional head of National Highway Wing of this department, with head quarters at Thiruvananthapuram and he is in control of and is responsible for its efficient functioning. He is also the technical advisor to Government on all matters relating to NH. A Deputy Chief Engineer in the rank of Superintending Engineer and other technical and non – technical officers assist the Chief Engineer. The office organisation includes a technical wing and an administrative wing under the control of a Deputy Chief Engineer and Administrative Assistant and Financial Wing under the control of a Financial Officer with sufficient complement of subordinate technical and ministerial staff. The Chief Engineer is responsible to initiate actions to get the proposals included in the annual plan, initiate actions to get the proposals approved from MoRTH, to accord TS to works as per delegation of powers, to allot funds under various heads to the divisions based on the allocation from MoRTH to submit proposals to MoRTH for declaration as NH etc.

The Execution of works in the department is controlled by the Superintending Engineers in South, Central and North Circles. For effective control and supervision of work site, the Circles are further divided into 8 Divisions. Various categories of staffs both

Technical and Ministerial are working under this offices. The administrative matters such as sanctioned strength, transfer and posting, creation and abolition of posts, number of vacancies etc in all officer under this wing are under the direct control of the Chief Engineer PWD Administration, Thiruvananthapuram.

In addition to Civil Wing offices, there is a mechanical subdivision at Alappuzha with Assistant Executive Engineer and three Assistant Engineers attached to National Highway Division Alappuzha for operation maintenance and repairs of equipments under National Highway wing, testing of fuel consumption, maintenance and repairs of vehicles of National Highway wing inspection and issue of fitness certificate for road construction.

Technical Wing: There are 11 National Highways in the State with a total length of 1781.57 Km State PWD is responsible for the up keeping of 1557.90 km and the remaining 223.67 km, by NHAI, Ministry of Road Transport and Highways have issued sanction for works amounting to NH(0) 300.77 Cr, NH (M amp R) PR 31.90 crore during the year 2018-19 for the development and maintenance of National Highways through State PWD and all works are arranged and a few are in progress. Technical Sanction are also issued by the state for works amounting to Rs. 801 Crore for works under central Road Fund which are administratively sanctioned by the ministry of Road Transport and Highways for the Development of 702.7 Km state roads other than National Highway.

9. OBJECTIVES AND PERFORMANCE OF THE ADMINISTRATION WING

r

E-Governance cell

PWD is in the process of ensuring transparency and efficiency in the functioning of the Department through implementation of complete e-Governance. PWD e-Governance Cell is entrusted with coordination of development, implementation and maintenance of various e-Governance Systems which are being implemented in PWD.

The status of various projects which are being executed through PWD e-Governance Cell are as follows:

Strengthening of IT infrastructure facilities in PWD Offices

There are over 780 PWD Offices statewide. PWD has undertaken an ambitious project of implementing total e-Governance in the Department in a stage wise manner. For ensuring the smooth roll out of various e-Governance projects, the IT hardware/software infrastructure and network facilities at various PWD Offices should be enhanced. It was decided to strengthen the IT infrastructure in PWD Offices in phased manner. The proposal for I phase procurement of computers and peripherals was submitted to Government in November 2017 and the same was revised and resubmitted for AS in April 2018. Later it was informed from the Government that additional amount required for this procurement cannot be sanctioned through the budgetary provision due to the post flood financial crunch. Hence the proposal was submitted for KSTP for inclusion in the ISAP component of the World Bank Loan for the Rebuild Kerala initiative. This proposal was sanctioned by the KSTP Steering committee and the I Phase procurement of computers and peripherals for PWD Offices state-wide (except NH, Design and KSTP Offices) were arranged through the CPRCS system on 30-03-2019.

E-Governance Project Implementation and Software Development

The status of main ongoing e-Governance initiatives in PWD are listed below:

PRICE Software

Project Information and Cost Estimation (PRICE) software is the core e-Governance Project of PWD. The software is developed jointly by PWD and NIC Kerala and the pilot phase was implemented in Buildings Wing of PWD in 2014. On the successful completion of the pilot phase implementation, Government has decided to adopt PRICE software for all engineering Departments in the State. Accordingly the first phase of the PRICE software is being successfully implemented in all State Engineering Departments and various Public Sector Units. This system covers the online estimate preparation, project initiation and administrative and technical sanction monitoring module.

Now the software development of PRICE Phase-II is in the final stages. This phase includes modules like Asset management system, Contract Management System (Including online contractor registration), Work management System, Online Bill Generation and Payment System etc. It is proposed to roll out PRICE Phase-II in all PWD offices state-wide from 01-06-2019..

Bio-Metric Attendance System (BMAS)

Government has decided to implement Bio-Metric Attendance System in PWD for improving the efficiency of PWD Offices. The pilot phase implementation of this project started in all Chief Engineers Offices and other PWD Offices in Public Office Complex from 01-04-2017. Now Government has issued orders to implement SPARK linked biometric attendance system in all state government offices of PWD. This is expected to be launched in the financial year 2019-20.

Upgradation of Official Web Portal of PWD - “WINGS”

The official web portal and e-Governance portal of PWD WINGS (Web Based Information and Governance System) was developed in the year 2007. Accordingly PWD IT Cell has taken up the upgradation of WINGS through C-DIT, one of the empanelled TSP of the Government. The project proposal for received from C-DIT was approved by the Government for an amount of 75.50 Lakh (Plus GST) in July 2018. Accordingly agreement was executed with C-DIT on 30-08-2018 for an amount of 59.25 Lakh (including GST). The software development for main web portal and online rest house reservation module is in the final stages.

GIS Based Roads & Bridge Monitoring System

PWD has developed GIS maps of various Roads and Bridge Asset maintained by PWD in the year 2006. However the asset data was not updated since 2007. Now the government has decided to upgrade this system in to GIS based Asset management system. The pilot phase project is taken up through KSTP. It was decided to engage Central Road Research Institute (CRRI) for the data updation and implementing the pilot project for a selected core road network.

E-office System

Government has decided to implement e-file system in PWD using the e-Office software of NIC which is being successfully implemented in the Government Secreteriat. The pilot phase implementation of this e-Office system will be done in PWD Chief Engineers Offices from the year 2018-19. The Government has accorded administrative sanction for the purchase of computers and peripherals in Chief Engineers Offices for e-Office pilot phase implementation on 1-02-2019. However the procurement was delayed due to shortage of fund in the financial year 2018-19. The pilot phase implementation is expected to commence in 2019-20 and request was send to IT Mission for permission for starting the e-Office system in PWD.

In addition to the above mentioned projects, various other common state e-Governance systems like SPARK, e-Procurement, EML, BIMS, BAMS etc are also being implemented in PWD Offices.

The expenditure for the various e-Governance implementations in PWD are met from the Plan Head 5054-80-800-82 (P) e-Governance in PWD and 3054-80-004-93 (P) e-Governance in PWD. The allocation in these head of accounts during the financial year 2018-19 were 200 lakh and 42 lakh. The expenditure under these Head of Account in financial year 2018-19 were 198.98 lakh and 21.13 lakh respectively. Further payment proposal amounting to 19 lakh submitted to Government was rejected due to shortage of funds.

The fund allotted under the above head of accounts are for all the e-governance activities of the department state wide (including software development, hardware procurement repair etc). The

budget allocation for each year in this head of account is usually very much below the projected demand and requirement. Strengthening maintaining of IT systems in a large Department like PWD which has over 800 offices state wide requires more budgetary allocation and for the efficient implementation of the e-governance initiatives like PRICE, e-tendering, WINGS etc, the hardware infrastructure needs to be upgraded frequently.

PWD e-Governance Cell is headed by Executive Engineer (e-Governance Cell). The staff details of the three units of e-Governance Cell are as Follows:

IT Cell

IT cell is entrusted with the duty of assessing the IT infrastructural requirement of various PWD Offices state-wide for smooth roll out of various e-Governance Projects in PWD. It also monitor the software development and implementation of various e-Governance Projects in PWD. This unit has one Assistant Executive Engineer (IT) and one Assistant Engineer (IT).

GIS Cell

GIS Cell is entrusted with the development, updation and monitoring of the GIS asset database of the Department. This unit has one Assistant Executive Engineer (GIS), one Assistant Engineer (GIS) and one Engineering Assistant (Electronics). At present the Engineers of GIS unit unit are being involved in the development and implementation of PRICE software which is being implemented in the Department.

RMMS Cell

RMMS cell is entrusted with the development of a computerised Road maintenance and Management System for PWD. This unit has one Assistant Executive Engineer (RMMS) and one Assistant Engineer (RMMS). At present the Engineers of GIS unit and RMMS unit are being involved in the development and implementation of PRICE software which is being implemented in the Department.

10. FINANCE

Source of funds: The main source of funds is from the Revenue of the State as depicted in the State Budget. In addition there was Central Government assistance also in the sections of Socialwelfare and family welfare. The total funds earmarked for the year 2018-19 under plan and non plansectors in each wing of PWD are as follows.

In the Roads and Bridges wing, a budget allocation was for an amount of Rs 136351.3 lakhsplan schemes and Rs 162380.9 lakhs under non plan schemes. In Buildings wing, a total amount of Rs112613.3 Lakhs was allotted in the buget under plan schemes and Rs 30179lakhs under non planschemes in this fiscal year. In National Highways wing, an amount of Rs 503.24 lakhs was expended under head of account 3054, Rs 1725.43 under head of account 5054 and Rs 1653.77 lakhs under MoRTH head.

11. CONCLUSION

During the year, PWD has spent Rs 266934.7 lakhs for Roads and Bridges, Rs 69548.93 lakhs for Buildings and Rs 3882.44 lakhs for National Highways. The cost of materials and wages of labours had shown an increasing trend in the year 2018-19. The performance as a whole is satisfactory.
